The International Telecommunication Union (ITU), Geneva Cities Hub and the City of Geneva are pleased to invite you to participate as a **High-Level guest speaker at the WSIS Forum 2022**, hosted by the ITU and co-organized by ITU, UNESCO, UNCTAD and UNDP with the engagement of more than 30 United Nations Agencies.

The WSIS Forum 2022 started on 15 March and will progress in a virtual format, culminating with a final High-level week from 30 May - 3 June 2022, which will take place physically, with enhanced remote participation, at the ITU Headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland. The event provides a unique opportunity to discuss local and national experiences and best practices to identify and scale up technology and innovative solutions in the ICT sector for urban development in a post-COVID19 world.
